

2011 Ungulate TAG Hoof Care Workshop Hosted by the Oakland Zoo June 3, 4, and 5, 2011



Under the guidance of the Oakland Zoo's farrier and experienced ungulate keeper and veterinary staff, examine the factors affecting hoof health for captive ungulates and obtain hands on experience with hoof care and trimming procedures with a wide array of species.





Participants will learn animal handling and restraint procedures as well as operant conditioning for medical procedures related to hoof care and trimming.
